Applicant Requirements

The applicant must demonstrate personable and professional conduct while interfacing with customers & contributing to a fun yet focused work environment. The applicant must have a valid driver's license (bonus points for a chauffeur license), provide their own transportation and be willing to have a background check and drug test. At least 1 year of carpentry experience with knowledge of residential construction, and experience with blown in insulation and spray foam insulation are preferred, but not required (paid training is provided). The applicant must be comfortable working in tight spaces like attics and crawl spaces, must be capable of repeatedly lifting 30lbs overhead, and must be comfortable working on a ladder.

Job tasks will include:

- Prepare the site for installation with drop cloths and wall plastic
- Install baffles and bath fan vents, air seal top plates and drop soffits
- Evenly install blown cellulose in attics
- Install vapor barrier and closed cell spray foam in crawl spaces
- Install closed cell spray foam on basement rim joists and attic knee walls
- Jobsite and work truck clean up.

Pay Scale
